

Lundgren Angus Ranch
9th Annual “Dollars” & “Sense” Production Sale
Friday, February 19, 2010
46 Bulls: \$2,657
28 Yrlg Heifers: \$846

The Lord blessed Larry Lundgren and family with a beautiful day to conduct the 9th Annual “Dollars” and “Sense” Production sale at the ranch south of Gove, KS. A large crowd filled the bleachers with a mix of long time buyers as well as some first time attendees. The activity was high as new buyers and old buyers alike were able to make genetics selections to add to their programs. Topping the bull division was Lot 24 at \$5,900. This E&B 1680 Precision 1023 son combined an adjusted yearling weight of 1380 (109 ratio) with a 113 IMF ratio in a deep sided, heavy muscled package. At \$5,000, Lot 33 was the second high selling bull of the day. This SAV Bismarck 5682 son was out of a first calf heifer. A huge birth to yearling EPD spread coupled with a 110 REA ratio resulted in this bull having lots of friends on sale day. The first LAR Total Package 744 sons were offered at this year’s sale and a son cataloged as Lot 5 topped them all at \$4,750. With an EPD spread of 1.0 to 108 and a REA ratio of 114 this individual also garnered a lot of attention sale day. A TC Total 410 son with big performance numbers and the highest \$B of the sale at +58.71 tallied up \$4,500 as the Lot 11 bull. Topping the two-year old division was Lot 58 at \$4,000. This son of LAR Notch 580 and out of a Morgan’s Direction daughter was a deep sided very attractive bull with a big spread from birth to yearling.

In the heifer division, three-quarter sisters that were cataloged as Lots 61 and 62 were first in the ring and tops of the day at \$1,300 each. These LCC New Standards daughters were out of GAR Exaltation 3144 sisters and should make an excellent set of females.
